



Working with new farmers to build successful businesses, find farmland, and excel in the field.

New Entry works locally, regionally, and across the country to strengthen local food systems by supporting new farmers.

Farmer Training

12 beginning farmers honed their skills on New Entry's three incubator training farm sites, including 7 first year farmers.

48 farmers-in-training completed the Farm Business Planning Course, either in person or online.

Provided over **375 hours** of technical assistance to new farmers.



Incubator Farm Sites

Over **100 participants** attended 11 hands-on field schools at the incubator farm sites.

Farm infrastructure improvements included the addition of over **\$5,000** of new hand tools and equipment for shared use.

World PEAS Food Hub

Over **30 farmers** generated more than **\$190,000 in income** from produce sales to the Food Hub.

Local produce delivered to over **380 households** through the World PEAS CSA.



Food Access

Distributed over **\$85,000 worth of produce** to community agencies reaching over **1,800 low-income seniors, families, and school age children.**



Food Systems

Fourth annual National Incubator Farm Training Initiative (NIFTI) Field School drew **70 participants** representing beginning farmer training programs from 28 states.

Community Food Projects Program worked with **155 organizations** from 44 states to facilitate over 230 hours of assistance.

Farmland Matching

Worked with **60 farmers** searching for farmland to lease or buy in New England.

Assisted over **40 landowners** in making their land available for farming and finding the right farmer match.



Livestock & Poultry Programs

Engaged 17 service providers in a regional working group to train farmers in parasite control methods for small ruminants.

Provided technical assistance to 31 poultry producers and **leveraged over \$28,000** in revenue for farmers using the Mobile Poultry Processing Unit.
