Title: Graphic Design Volunteer

Purpose: The graphic design volunteer will work independently to support the New Entry Sustainable Farming Project (NESFP) with basic graphic design help. As a small non-profit working to train beginning famers, we do not have the resources to do higher level graphic design work.

Tasks/Responsibilities: Create informative, visually appealing, and easy to understand posters, flyers, outreach materials, social media graphics etc... while following the NESFP formatting guidelines. Volunteer is expected to meet required deadlines, make changes based on staff feedback, and ask staff questions if they are unsure about a project



Time Commitment: Since this work is being done on a volunteer basis, we respect the fact that graphic design volunteers may reject a project if they do not have time to finish it before a deadline.

Site/Supervision: Work can be done remotely and the volunteer will report to the New Entry Volunteer Coordinator for guidance on all projects

Skills: Graphic design experience required.
